### AXA Achievement Scholarship

**Deadline:** December 15, 2015

**For:** This scholarship is open to high school seniors enrolling in an accredited two-year or four-year college or university in the United States for the entire 2016-2017 academic year. Students must demonstrate ambition and self-drive as evidenced by outstanding achievement in school, community, or work-related activities.

**Details:** \$10,000 scholarships are awarded to one student from each state. Ten national winners will win an additional \$15,000 scholarship, for a total of \$25,000.

**Deadline:** December 15, 2015
